*A 30% sibling discount is offered for each family with more than one child enrolled in Co-op. The discount is good for the lowest price tuition.

** Families must also enroll with the Community College of Spokane for 3 credit hours (Infant class, Toddler 1 & 2) or 4 credit hours (Multi-age Preschool or two enrolled children) per quarter. The cost is \$16.35/credit. (Note this is subject to change.) We have three quarters during an academic year, fall, winter and spring. There is no additional SCC fee to enroll a sibling in Family Day.

All children who are attending will need current immunization records on file at Manito Co-op.

Enrollment begins February 12th and closes on March 2nd at 9:30 am. A lottery will be held for any full classes on March 9th at 9:30 am. Class lists will go out March 12th.

Priority for registration is as follows:

1. Currently enrolled families who meet Seminar requirement*
2. Alumni and currently enrolled families who do not meet Seminar requirement*
3. Waitlisted families from the 2017-18 school year
4. New families

*Current families are allowed to miss **no more than two** monthly co-op seminars throughout the year in order to keep priority enrollment status for the following year.
